

READY FOR THE BEST WEEK EVER?! CIY MOVE IS HERE!

(If you are receiving this and will not be on the trip, please notify me immediately!)

INFORMATIONAL MEETING and DEPARTURE: Departure time is set for **8:00 a.m. on Sunday, July 8**. We will spend a few minutes before we depart talking about details you need to know for the trip. Please arrive around 7:30 so we can meet and pray promptly at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stay with your students for that meeting.

COST: ***Your remaining balance is due when we leave!*** If you have questions on how much you owe, contact Brian at bwilde@countrysidecc.com. You will also need money for 5 meals while we are on the road. (Sunday lunch will be at LEGENDS Outdoor Mall in KC, \$10-20, with the other 4 meals being fast food.) All other meals are covered by CIY. Other optional costs for students may include road snacks, shopping/activities in KC, CIY merchandise at the event such as shirts, hats, books, etc. and there may be other convenience items available for purchase on campus. Your student is responsible for his/her own money during the trip.

FORMS: You must fill out a new CCC release form and behavior agreement ***to be turned in with your balance on July 8!*** I have also included CIY Move rules and packing list in this packet. IN CASE OF EMERGENCY:

Students are allowed to have cell phones on the trip. However, we ask that you contact Brian Wilde in case of an emergency. His cell phone number is 316-210-1197.

ITINERARY:

We depart for Kansas City at 8:00 a.m. after our information and prayer meeting (see above). We will spend the day doing various fun activities in Kansas City on Sunday, staying overnight at Revive Church in Independence, MO (be sure to pack sleeping back or something good for a floor). After a morning activity on Monday, we head to Lincoln, NE for the CIY Move event hosted at the University of Nebraska. We leave just before dinner on Friday, putting our arrival time back in Wichita at around 10:00 p.m. depending on the events of the day. Students will call parents on the way home with an exact arrival time.

RULES: Cell phones/electronics are allowed on the trip! **We ask that they only be used during travel and as instructed as during the event. If an adult leader feels like a student is abusing this privilege (overuse, disengaging from the event, inappropriate content, late night chatting, etc.) we will confiscate their devices.** See list for more guidelines.

PACKING: Please see the enclosed packing list. Take note of the **swimsuit policy**, and make sure you bring modest suits. Also, pay attention to the mention of **bedding needs** as we will be sleeping on a church floor on Sunday night and dorm beds the rest of the week.

KC DETAILS: Students are encouraged to be wearing their swimsuits under their clothes when they arrive at the church on Sunday morning, as we are going to Schlitterbahn Waterpark after spending a couple hours at LEGENDS Outdoor Mall. Showers are also available at Schlitterbahn, which is encouraged as we will not have access to showers at Revive Church. We will have one more group activity Monday morning before heading to Lincoln. Get excited!

Packing Checklist

- **Bible and Pen**
- **Modest Casual Clothing** (7 days. If you have to question something, don't bring it. If you need guidelines, the following items are definitely unacceptable: Short Shorts, Sagging Pants, Bikinis, Miniskirts, Spaghetti Straps, Low Cut Tops)
- **Rec/Athletic Clothes** (if you plan to use the on-campus rec facility during free time)
- **Sleeping Bag** (or bedding that would be comfortable on a bare floor and a twin dorm bed)
- **Pillow**
- **Swimsuit** (modesty! One Piece or Modest Tank-inis only. No bikinis or speedos.)
- **Towel(s)** (2 recommended- 1 bath, 1 swimming)
- **Toiletries** (please don't forget deodorant...)
- **Money for 5 meals** (4 fast food, one medium priced)
- **Spending Money for Merch and Travel** (optional)
- **Positive Attitude!**

CIY MOVE Rules: (make sure you look over CCC rules as well on Medical Release Form)

1. Respect others, yourself, and property.
2. No guys in girl's dorms beyond the front lobby and vice versa.
3. Alcohol, tobacco, drugs and weapons are absolutely prohibited
4. Everyone must be in their dorms by the designated "In Dorm Time".
5. For security reasons, no students with backpacks are allowed into the auditorium or cafeteria.
6. Follow the schedule. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there.
7. During sessions, stay in your assigned seating. Please follow the posted seating chart.
8. Do not leave the auditorium once the speakers begin talking.
9. Respect the campus – no TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc. No practical jokes!
10. Do not move furniture as you will be charged for any assessed damage.
11. Do not dial 911 unless it is a true emergency.
12. Absolutely no fireworks at any time during MOVE or while on campus property.
13. No food deliveries of any kind to the campus.
14. Students may leave campus ONLY with adult supervision; those staying behind must have an adult present.
15. Follow the dress guidelines.

MOVEictionary: A quick glossary of terms you'll hear thrown around while at MOVE.

Morning Show

Make sure you are ready each morning for the MOVE Morning Show. This is a daily student only session led by the emcee for the week and chalk-full of ridiculousness.

Extended Recreation

This is an opportunity for you to enjoy an extended afternoon of free time. With your group, you may leave campus to check out sites in the area, participate in a service project or enjoy the many activities available on campus.

The Station

The Station is your one stop shop for MOVE gear, sweet books, etc... Think of the Station as the mall, but with less sketchy food and middle schoolers. If you don't want to bring a ton of cash, the Station takes MasterCard, VISA, Amex and Discover. Be sure to know the location and posted hours of when they will be open throughout the week.

The HUB

Man, what CAN'T you do at the HUB? This is where you'll want to go to sign up for tournaments, the Alternative, find your lost and subsequently found things... basically any question that you have can probably be answered at the HUB. Purchase a star and name it after that person you've been dating for 3 months... That's something you can't do at the HUB.

Encounter Time

Following the Morning Session, you will be dismissed to your Encounter Time and Small Groups (D-Group). This is an opportunity for you to participate in devotions that are tied to the daily themes. You can find these devotions in your student booklet. If you have any questions, look to your leaders as they will be prepared to help you make the most of this time.

The Next Level

If you are a graduated senior, MOVE invites you to attend The Next Level which is an in-depth Bible study taught by the Morning Speaker while everyone else is in their Encounter Time. This is a great opportunity to for you to get an inside glimpse of that day's theme, ask questions and be challenged in your faith.

The Alternative

MOVE provides you an opportunity to share your talents (singing, instrumental, bands, skits, poetry, comedic, etc.). You may sign up for The Alternative at the MOVE Station but do so quickly as spots are limited and fill up quickly. Come rehearsed and ready to amaze your fellow MOVE attendees!

COUNTRYSIDE CHRISTIAN CHURCH YOUTH GROUP BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

1. When transportation is involved in any youth activity, all students ride designated vehicle(s). No student is allowed to drive, unless they have expressed permission from their parents taking full responsibility for their driving.
2. Students are expected to comply with any and all instructions given by adult youth staff members.
3. Students are to demonstrate respect for the Lord by demonstrating respect for church facilities and vehicles, as well as any facilities, etc. at off-campus events. Should a student's actions cause damage or breakage, he/she will be held responsible for repair or replacement of the broken or damaged item.
4. When attending church activities, all students are expected to participate in those activities: not hang around outside, roam the hallways, etc.
5. When we return from an activity, parents are to pick up their students at the time stated. Because we try very hard both to accurately pinpoint our return time and to notify parents from the road on those rare occasions when we do experience major delays, we ask that parents be here to meet us when we arrive, rather than waiting at home for a phone call from their student.
6. Upon return from any road trip, students are expected to help clean the vehicle(s) before claiming their luggage & departing.
7. In the interest of maintaining a positive, Christ-centered atmosphere at all youth functions, we ask that students keep modesty in mind in their clothing choices, guys and girls alike. *If you have a question about it, don't bring it.* For swimwear- no speedos or suggestively tight suits. Girls should wear one-piece suits or modest tankinis. In addition, clothing worn to youth events should be free of ungodly images and messages. Adult leaders have the right to ask you to change at any time.
8. When preparing for a trip, the youth pastor will inform parents and students about the event policy concerning cell phone and electronic device usage. This may vary depending on the event. You must adhere to what is told concerning such usage. On those occasions when devices are permitted, students are to exercise the utmost discernment in the music, video and game content they choose to bring. Our youth leaders reserve the right to permanently confiscate inappropriate material brought on a trip and confiscate electronic devices if the right to use them is being abused. 9. When at a large multi-church event such as CIY conferences, the youth group is to sit together at all sessions. Additionally, students are not allowed to be away from the group at any time (to participate with another group or otherwise) without another CCC student with them AND notifying an adult leader prior to activity.
10. This should go without saying, but for the record, alcohol, tobacco of any kind, illegal drugs, firearms, knives, pornography, foul language, public displays of affection which venture beyond hand-holding, uncooperative attitudes, and derogatory remarks to or about the youth staff will not be permitted to be a part of any Countryside youth function.
11. *"And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father."*

12. **The youth staff of Countryside Christian Church reserves the right to dismiss or suspend from any youth activity any young person who demonstrates an attitude of indifference to God and to others by willfully and remorselessly violating these guidelines. If the violation occurs during the course of an out-of-town event, dismissal may include sending the student home at his/her parents' expense.**

We have read these guidelines. We agree to abide by them, and understand the consequences of not following them.
